

II. RS-232 Control Wiring

Wire RS-232 control to a female DB9 as follows:



Connect female DB9 to projector port labeled *Serial Control*. *Serial Adapters* (for NRC only): None

III. Projector Configuration

Set Auto Source to OFF— Using the Proxima menus navigate to the *Sources* menu, which is found inside the Settings menu, and *UNCHECK* the *AUTO SOURCE* option.

Set Auto Power to OFF - Using the Proxima menus navigate to the *System* menu, which is found inside the Settings menu, and **UNCHECK** the AUTO POWER option.

Set Power Save to OFF - Using the Proxima menus navigate to the *System* menu, which is found inside the *Settings* menu, and *UNCHECK* the *POWER SAVE* option.
